



No to the systematization of camps

European demonstration against the outrageous directive

Wednesday, May 7th, 2008

Brussels, square Schuman, 12.30 a.m.

On May, 20th 2008, a proposal for a Return Directive concerning the detention and the deportation of migrants will be submitted to the European Parliament.

This proposal, in the continuity of the European policies with respect of immigration and asylum which are based only on safe and repressive aspects, formalizes the erasure of the guarantees and fundamental protections of the people.
If it were to be adopted, this proposal would allow:

- the detention of migrants which could be extended up to 18 months for people whose only offence is to have crossed borders and want to live in Europe.
- the detention of minors, in disregard for the respect of the overriding interest of the child
- the 5 years re-entry ban in Europe for migrants who are expelled, which stigmatizes and criminalizes these people.

With respect to these violations of Human Rights, we are asking members of the European Parliament to reject this proposal for the "Return Directive".

Let's say no to this systematization of the camps and the deportation of people who are deemed as undesirable.
